	Communication: I understand I must notify MESA if I change my primary email; MESA uses a
	confidential email system to share program events with MESA students.
	Academic Progress: I understand I must demonstrate Academic Progress in order to remain an
	active MESA member. Academic Progress means:
	I will submit to the MESA Director/Counselor each fall and spring semester an accurate long-
	term educational plans (MAP) consistent with transferring as a STEM Major
	I will enroll in math and science courses aligned with my individual educational plan
	I will notifying the MESA Counselor if I drop a math or science class during the semester
	I will notify the MESA Counselor if I change my major.
	Transfer Progress: Because AA-AS degree completion/transferring is a MESA program measurable
	outcome, I agree to notify MESA:
	If I no longer register for classes at SRJC
	If I leave SRJC in order to attend a different community college
	When I complete a certificate or AA/AS-degree
	When I transfer to a four-year college or university.
